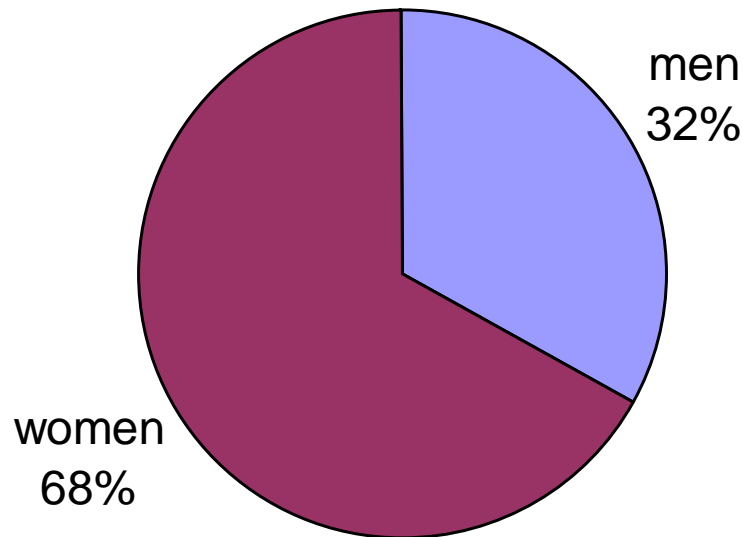

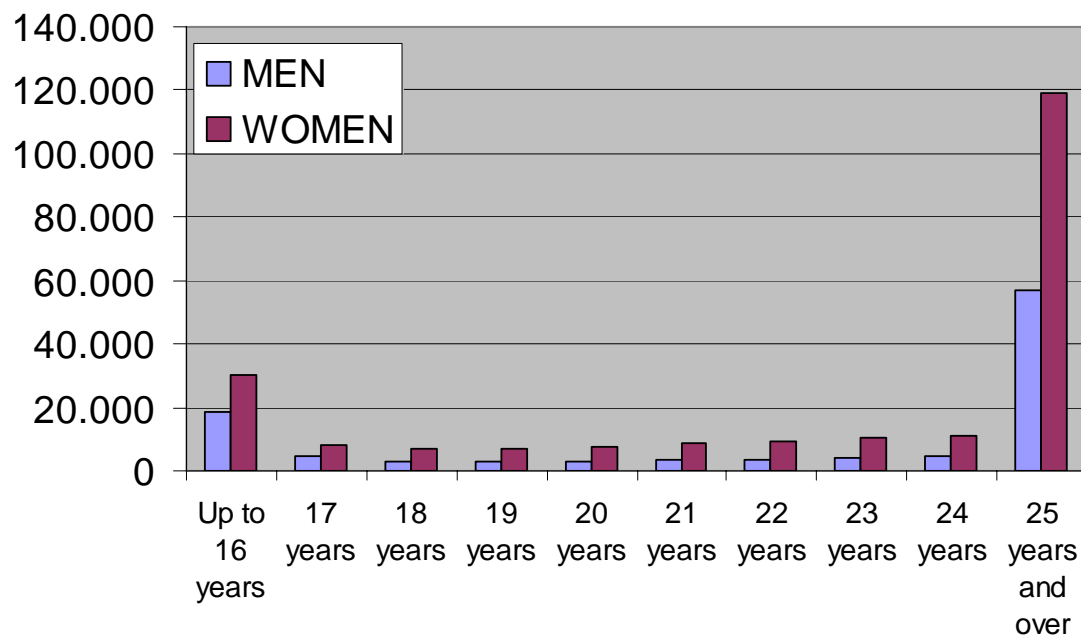

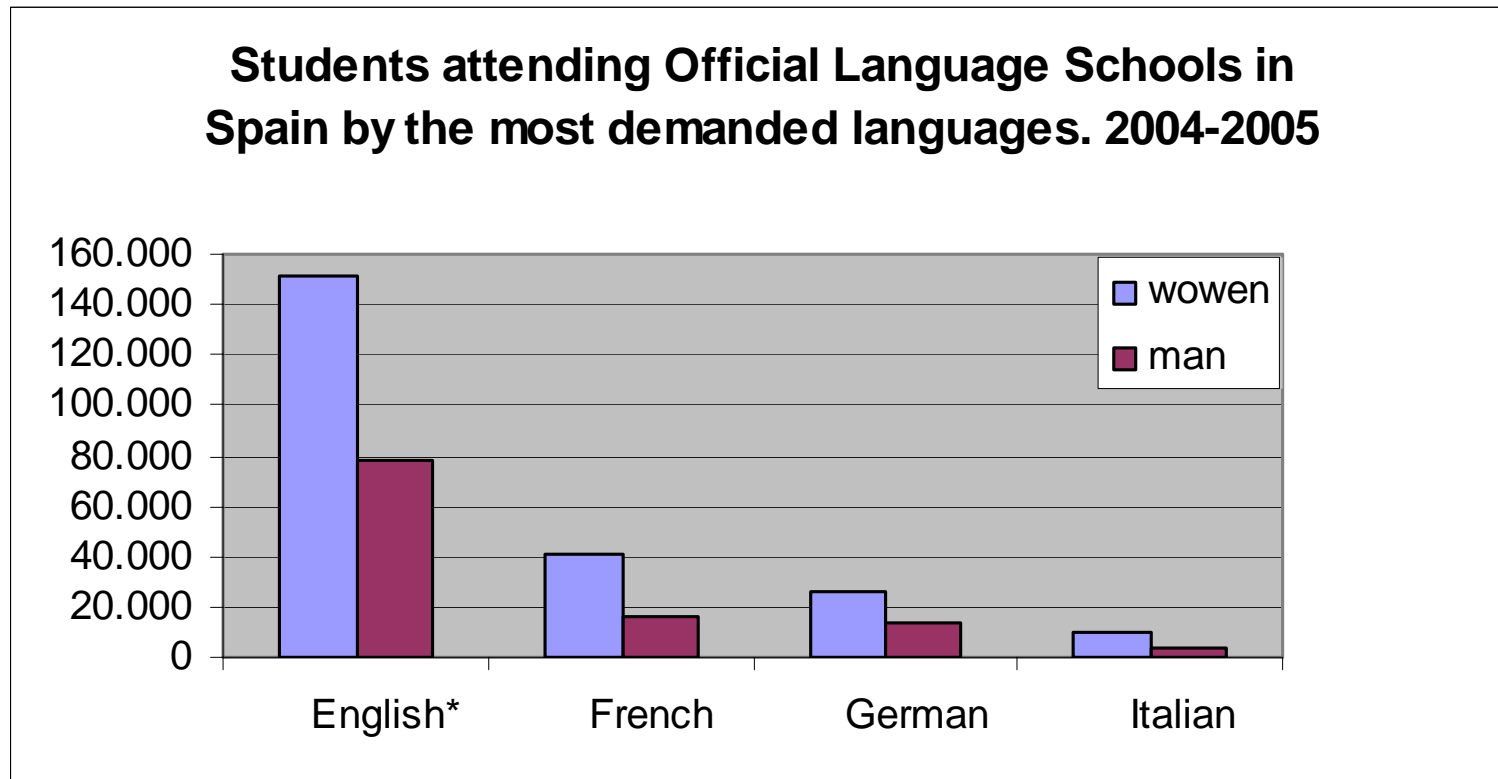
Why love language in Spain?

Who we are?
